Interesting Feng Shui Mausoleum in Belgium

Originally Feng Shui was better known in China under the “*Yin Feng Shui*”. Masters were called to define and choose the auspicious sites for the burial of the departed ones. Honouring the ancestors is essential in the Chinese culture. Minding their elderly relatives as well as caring for their ultimate rest place is believed to project good luck onto their descendants.

While travelling in Europe, I came across an interesting Mausoleum in the locality of Court St Etienne near Brussels in Belgium. Built by an erudite and visionary that travelled the world, the noble Eugene Gobelet d’Alviella that passed away in 1925, his tomb is filled



with esoteric symbols.

Its height of about 12 metres is sitting on a heavy stone square base of 5 metres. The cupola is held by well-proportioned columns that he calculated in great awareness of the sacred proportions. The ornaments on the monument are of symbols from many different cultures and religions, their engraving are decorated of precious golden leaves.

Gobelet’s aim with his mausoleum was to send out RESPECT and SERENITY. His interest in various re-

ligions and believes were to him the universal seek for harmony, love and respect to all people. The way Gobelet erected it in sacred proportions, with precise building materials on a *Feng Shui* area on top of an underground water vein was showing his wisdom of geomancy and communication with the *Unseen*.

The synergy of the symbols such as the Hebraic *YHWH*, the *Celtic Hammer*, the *Swastika*, the *Alfa* and *Omega* (only to name a few) combined with some of the quotes of *Buddha*, the Apostle Marc, Confucius were spreading through his mausoleum-antennae



around the region and around the planet.

Unfortunately... over the years, his mausoleum was abandoned until recently when the authorities decided to renovate it.

I was lucky to visit the cemetery where the Mausoleum is located while a patient tradesman was cleaning its blue stoned roof. He shared with me the whole story of the renovation explaining that the fragile blue stone empty boxed roof had been filled with 3,000 litres of concrete and that it was leaking water ever since. That

same morning he had met on site the architect in charge of the



renovation project who was now talking of adding some lead to stop the water leak.

Hearing those very words, I felt the essences of Gobelet communicating with me and sharing his insight. They were destroying his work! They were annihilating the resonance of Serenity!

Gobelet’s initial aim of antennae was destroyed by filling the on purpose empty ‘resonating speakers’ felt like an outrage to his spirit. I was there to share this with Francis Lesire, the tradesman who was humbly following instructions. There is no coincidence. I dare even say that the architect’s interference with a sacred purpose could well become a serious threat and danger for him.

What will happen with this mausoleum is in the hands of Gobelet’s Spirit and future will tell.

In conclusion, I simply want to share my readers of the importance of RESPECT in every culture.

In China, this *Yin Feng Shui* of burial sites is only kept in the outskirts of cities if so.

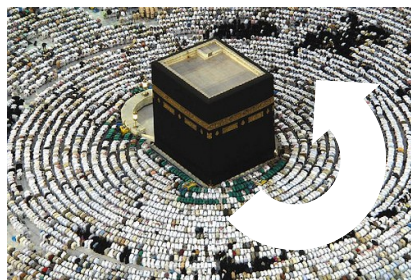

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How underlying Water can have an effect on our Health

The sketch represented on the next page is the top level of a three story building in Sydney.

Most of the staff members are allocated on this level. Over the period of three years, staff became sick with serious illnesses, undiagnosed viruses and the morale become increasingly toxic.

The number of staff increased putting desks in positions that caused lack of energy flow and added to the toxicity. The turnover of staff was high and treatment of staff from management and from other colleagues became intolerable.

This is a beautiful old sandstone building built in Sydney in the early 1800's. Originally it was a private residence. The lower ground floor is below road surface and when it rains, water pours through the sandstone support walls into the kitchen and walk way outside the bathrooms. These rooms and underground garage are constantly having issues with puddles that won't dissipate.

The middle floor has stairs going up and down. Other rooms on this floor consist of a library, conference room, tea room, computer and stock room, IT office

and reception. All these rooms have floor to ceiling doors that were frequently opened and due to the fact that staff's time is limited in these rooms, no adverse affects have been shown.

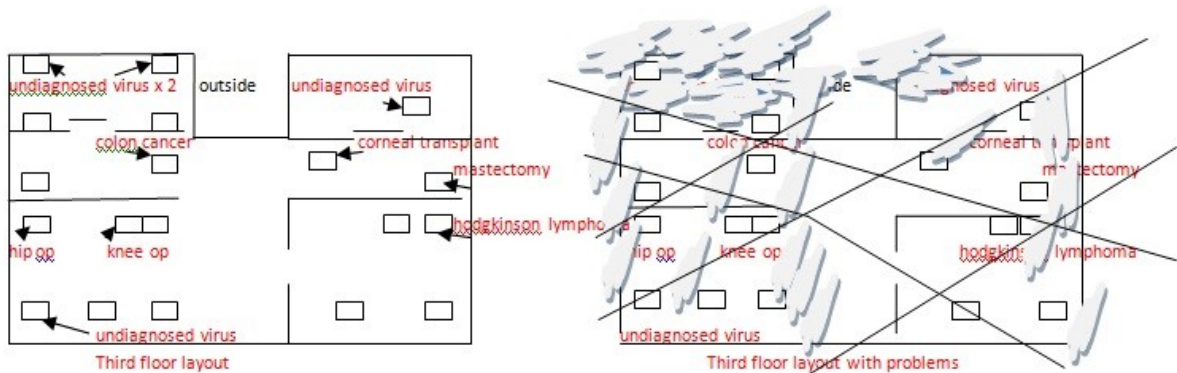
The top level where most of the staff is situated is cramped, impersonal and the two back rooms have little ventilation therefore causing stagnant energy.

Recently when I was studying Feng Shui with Roseline, we dowsed the floor plan of the third floor of this building and above on the right hand side is the findings.

How underlying Water can have an effect on our Health (continued)

Clearly there is an enormous amount of water (white cloudy patches on the right hand side sketch) – stagnant water that is sitting below the building underground and that would explain the flooding and excessive water during rain on the lower ground floor. I think if you researched the land in the early 1800's you would find an underground basin of water not only under this building but throughout the area. Due to population growth buildings have been erected over this basin, causing it to stagnate unbeknownst to the residents.

This water would hold the unconsciousness of the people working there as well as their toxic thoughts and arguments causing the environment to be detrimental to their health and their happiness.

The ley lines (black lines on the right hand sketch) are fairly general except for the two desks that the staff members quickly developed Hodgkinson lymphoma and colon cancer – note that the ley lines are crossed over each other

at these desks and also the excessive water. Clearly these diseases take some time to manifest so all the blame cannot be placed on the ley lines but they certainly would have enhanced the outcome and then played a part in the recovery. However the ley lines could certainly be the cause of so many undiagnosed viruses.

So we see the problem and what can we do about it? . The purpose of Feng Shui is to create environments in which chi flows smoothly to achieve physical and mental health. How can we, as Feng Shui consultants, stop the toxicity and bring back harmony to this place considering that the problem lies underground.

Firstly understanding the effect of underground streams.

Just as water erodes rocks on the beach, underground streams have had the same effect beneath the Earth's surface. This process alters the electromagnetic frequency of the Earth so that it is out of our frequency range. The energy spirals produced by the underground streams or stagnant water effect and is felt inside any buildings di-

rectly overhead. Where a clockwise spiral meets an anti-clockwise spiral, ill health may be experienced by people situated above them. Where the spirals meet other forces such as leys the problems are accentuated.

Cure: Firstly put a large water fountain in the front yard to figuratively draw the negative spirals of energy to the surface through the fountain and to be released into the atmosphere.

Secondly, individuals can take precautions by putting on their desks a salt lamp or water fountain and move their desks off the ley lines, especially the crossed ley lines.

Thirdly each room should be assessed with the magic square and the five elements processed and finally staff should be aware to move about frequently and have a break from their desks to relieve the affect of both water and ley lines.

The Kangaroo—Sacrifice

The creator gifted Kangaroo with an intuitive ability to follow the rains. She also holds the deep understanding of what “sacrifice to survive” really means.



Red and Grey Kangaroos both smell the air to pinpoint a distant storm that may bring relief to this great parched land. After a gift of rain, Kangaroo will intuitively arrive to ‘mow’ the fresh coverage as quickly as it grows. Once complete, she will move again as quickly as she came to follow the next wisp of rain on the breeze.

With European settlement and modern farming practices, abundant fresh pastures have replaced dry bush land. Man has developed the ability to supply permanent water to places that would otherwise have been arid. This has provided Kangaroo with an unprecedented abundance of grazing land and a population explosion has ensued.

Kangaroo has also evolved with an innate ability to control the birth timing of her young. In periods of drought she can postpone the birth until more abundant times. Once the rain brings relief she can choose to give birth within days, assuring her young will have plenty.

By mastering her birth cycle, kangaroo can sustain her species even during harsh times. Once drought

breaks there will be an immediate increase in numbers once more.

Kangaroo can have one Joey in her uterus, one in the pouch and at the same time, an adolescent suckling outside. In times of need the offspring in the pouch is sacrificed but it can be replaced within days when the season is good.

Kangaroo knows too well, that life will always present the need to sacrifice something we love in order to sustain our existence. When attacked by a predator, Kangaroo's first response is to flee in order to protect herself and her young. If a safe escape is impossible however, she will toss the Joey out of her pouch into the path of the would-be attacker. She sacrifices a loved part of herself to ensure the continued growth of her species. This game of life and death seems harsh to the human observer, but Kangaroo knows the value of sacrifice.

If Kangaroo attempted to outrun her pursuer with the weight of a Joey in the pouch, her pursuer would catch and kill them both. By making the hard decision to sacrifice her young, she will continue to reproduce and fulfill her role to sustain her kind. “It is my responsibility to sacrifice what is important to me in order to bring continued new life to my species” she says.

If Kangaroo has come to your hand today she brings your awareness to the considerable value of sacrifice to continue growth upon your journey. Kangaroo tells you

“Life and death bring balance to ensure the survival of all who walk upon our great Mother Earth.”

She asks you to consider *“Perhaps it is time to sacrifice a part of yourself in order to escape potential danger or stagnancy? Do you need to consciously separate yourself from something you are attached to in order to reach safer or higher ground?”*

Kangaroo reminds you that the pain of sacrifice passes. When the threat is left behind, life soon finds rhythm once more. She asks you to consider *“Is the weight of your attachment to someone or something slowing your escape from a potentially negative situation? If so, Kangaroo suggests “Be like me, what seems hard now could potentially sustain you.”*

Kangaroo medicine says *“Become better not bitter about your daily sacrifices. What you feel you have lost today will return to you soon, the cycle of life continues for eternity.”*

She reminds you of the key. *“Forgive yourself and others in order that new energy and opportunity can emerge to quickly replace your loss. The birth of new opportunity is in your hands. You can stay where you are or choose to sacrifice the energy or attachment to free yourself for new potential.”*

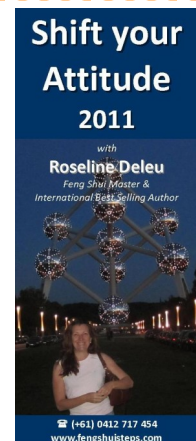
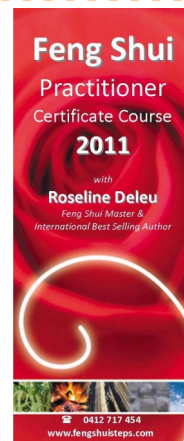
